Subject: Updated Campus Measures against the Developments in COVID-19 Pandemic

Dear Students,

We hope this email finds you safe and well.

As stated in the earlier announcement on Learning and Teaching Arrangement for AY2021/22 issued on 12 October 2021, unless otherwise announced due to new situations following advice from CHP and/or EDB, all classes will continue to be conducted face-to-face on campus in Semester 2. For students who are required to serve compulsory testing or mandatory quarantine notice and requirements, special assistance would be provided to support learning.

Arrangements for Students Subjected to Compulsory Testing/Mandatory Quarantine

Individuals subjected to compulsory testing or mandatory quarantine as required by the Hong Kong Government should not enter campus premises until all required test(s) has/have been done and negative notification of the last test required has been received. **Students who find themselves in such circumstances are required to inform the institutes via email (covid-19@cihe.edu.hk), and submit the following information/documentation:**

- I. Name
- II. Student ID
- III. Programme studied
- IV. Year level
- V. Official Notification(s) issued by the HKSAR Government requiring compulsory testing/mandatory quarantine, such as:
 - a. Compulsory Testing Notice (*強制檢測公告*) or;
 - b. Screen capture photo of “LeaveHomeSafe” Exposure Notification
- VI. Date(s) of compulsory testing as required by HKSAR Government and/or;
- VII. Start + End dates of mandatory quarantine

The Registry will review the submitted information upon receipt. If deemed appropriate, the Registry will issue an approval document certifying the student’s eligibility for seeking alternative teaching arrangements during a specified period (‘the approved period’). **During the approved period, students will be responsible for informing relevant teachers of their situation and for seeking appropriate alternative teaching arrangements.** Students should not enter campus premises during the approved period.

After the approved period has elapsed, students are required to submit proof of a negative test result via email (covid-19@cihe.edu.hk) before re-entry into campus premises is permitted.



Campus Hygiene and Precautionary Measures

Considering the latest developments of the COVID-19 pandemic in Hong Kong, CIHE and CBCC will implement the measures detailed below to safeguard the health and safety of the students and staff. This is to ensure potential disruption to learning and teaching activities is kept to a minimum level. Please note that students will be refused entry into the campus if they fail to fulfill the following requirements:

No.	Effective Date	Measures
1.	24 JAN 2022 onwards	To be eligible for entry into campus premises, students must produce proof of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Having received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine or;• A valid negative test result for COVID-19 obtained within 7 days prior to the date of entry¹.
2.	24 FEB 2022 onwards	To be eligible for entry into campus premises, students must produce proof of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Having received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine or;• For individuals who have been exempted from vaccination arrangements due to medical reasons by the approval of the institutes, a valid test result for COVID-19 obtained within 3 days prior to the date of entry¹.
3.	24 MAR 2022 onwards	To be eligible for entry into campus premises, students must produce proof of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Having received at least two doses of COVID-19 vaccine or;• For individuals who have been exempted from vaccination arrangements due to medical reasons by the approval of the institutes, a valid test result for COVID-19 obtained within 3 days prior to the date of entry¹.

To conclude, we will continue to critically monitor the COVID-19 pandemic situation in Hong Kong and will review measures implemented continuously to best safeguard the health and safety of our students and staff. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
